SYNOPSIS

Fiesta de Pueblo is a young nonprofit organization doing important work on behalf and for the benefit of all people of all Hispanic origins in the region. For several years, the programming of the Fiesta de Pueblo was limited to one major festival per year, held in Greenacres, Florida in January. This extraordinarily successful event drew audiences from around the region and served both Hispanic and non-Hispanic people with arts, entertainment, and fellowship. As the population of South Florida grows and the needs of its people increase, there is a related need for Fiesta de Pueblo to expand.

In the next three years, the leadership of Fiesta de Pueblo has an ambitious goal to rent and, ultimately, purchase a facility that will house all the organization's activities and act as a hub for its operations. This unique vision, when realized, will provide a place of great importance to the 21 Hispanic groups that make Florida their home.

Art classes, demonstrations, cooking events, and meetings will all take place is this resource center, called the Fiesta De Pueblo Multicultural Community Resource Center. It is a place for current and aspiring artists and entrepreneurs. Curriculum will be focused on assisting to produce successful businesses and professionals. Participants will learn about cultural lifestyles and attitudes necessary to keep our community united and moving forward. Where possible, programs will be offered on a weekly basis with an average class time of 2 hours per class. Taught each week by one of our instructors, and the class plan and activities follow a consistent format regardless of which instructor is teaching. The Fiesta De Pueblo teaches seminars, courses, clinics and workshops in arts and crafts, music, dancing, singing, painting, cooking, sewing, e-commerce, leadership, sports, business law, taxes, finances, accounting, marketing, and management. The Center was designed to assist all those interested to accomplish their goals. With underwriting, most of the programs will be offered at no-cost for participants.

To accomplish these ambitious goals, new earned and contributed revenues will be sought, secured, and tracked through enhanced staffing and accounting procedures. In addition, the Board of Directors will grow as the programming grows with a goal of adding seven new Board members, providing excellent training for individual Board members, and engaging them in the governance of the organization through the execution of "best practices." When fully realized, this Plan will lead to a doubling of the organization's annual budget, enhanced program services through classes and larger events, and reaching and serving at least 50% more people through programs and events.
